## **PRESS RELEASE - COVID-19**

The Board of Directors and Management of Banks DIH Ltd wish to communicate to our Shareholders and the General Public the measures which have been implemented as our response to the issues which have arisen as a consequence of the Corona Virus Pandemic which currently affects both our Nation and the Wider World.

We have implemented hand sanitising requirements and body temperature recording procedures utilising hand held digital thermometers at the entrance to our Thirst Park Facilities. Persons who visit our Company who visibly present symptoms of the Cold and/or Flu Virus and body temperatures above 98.4°F/37°C will be denied entry. All employees who on reporting for duties present symptoms of having contracted the Cold and/or Flu Virus will be sent off the job for a mandatory fourteen (14) day period and until they present a medical certificate indicating the resumption of good health. Our Drivers, Salesmen, Sales Helpers and Merchandising Staff have been issued with equipment to sanitise their hands continually over the period that they are on duty and will not be permitted to engage in any selling activities should they present symptoms of having contracted the Cold or Flu Virus.

The washroom facilities across the Company will be sprayed and sanitised twice daily utilising a chlorine solution at the start and at the end of the work day.

The Public seating and in-house dining facilities and contact surfaces within our Restaurants will be wiped and sanitised using a chlorine solution after use by persons who visit those facilities.

Signage has been posted across the Company to sensitise Staff Members and the Public of the need to regularly wash their hands and to engage in good personal hygiene practices. We will continue to engage our Staff Members as frequently as is necessary to encourage them to be concerned and involved as we work with our Public Health Authorities to confront the harsh realities which this Pandemic has presented to our Nation and the wider Communities.
